Faith, Hope, Love – Bishop’s Call to Mission. There are still some addressed envelopes at the back of BOTH churches; please DO check to see if there is one for you.

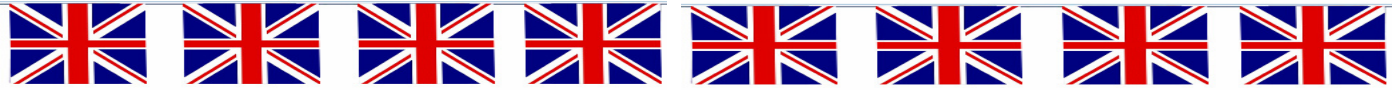

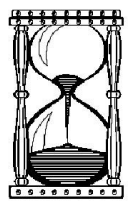

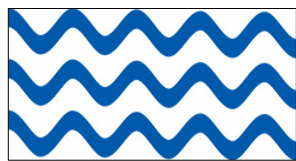
